1. This tournament is run by the Nosbonsing Anglers & Hunters. The entry fee is **\$130.00** per team (2-person) Team **this fee includes your BIG Fish**, officials must receive a signed and competed entry form accompanied by a cheque or money order prior to the tournament. Cheques are payable to **NOSBONSING ANGLERS & HUNTERS** Entries are non-refundable after July 31st, 2020

2. Due to the COVID restrictions the format has been adjusted to meet the requirements set forth by the Ontario Government. We will not be having our usual gathering at the end of the tournament. Participants will do their final measurements at the end of the tournament hours and leave the premise. We will send all participants the results by email. You will receive your prize by mail.

3. Tournament hours Sunday August 16th, 2020 from 8:00am to 3:00pm, trickle start.

4. Maximum of 55 teams will be allowed to compete.

5. Tournament headquarters is the public dock on Big Moose Rd. located on Lake Nosbonsing.

6. All entrants must start their fishing day by checking in at the Tournament headquarters for boat inspection and must return by 3:00pm to measure. A minimum of 15 inches will be in effect. Entrants returning late to measure will be penalized by 1" per minute after 3:00pm.

7. Tournament boundaries are the entire lake of Nosbonsing to Bonfield bridge.

8. Only pike will be allowed for entry. All other species must be immediately released.

9. Each team must have at least 1 (one) participant 18 years of age or older.

10. Each boat must have some type of operational aerating device for live fish storage.

11. Only artificial bait shall be used.

12. All entrants must wear approved life jackets while travelling (other than drifting or trolling)

13. Boats may be inspected by Officials at any point during the tournament.

14. No other persons, other than the entrants or Tournament officials are allowed in their boat.

15. No participants can touch shore during tournament, except at the official headquarters.

16. No drugs or alcoholic beverages are allowed on your boat.

17. All Federal and Provincial Fisheries and Boating Regulation must always be observed. A minimum distance of 100 feet must be maintained between competitor's boats.

18. All standings shall be determined on a total length basis, including any applicable live release bonus. Any tie will be decided by the team's longest pike, including the live release bonus.

19. The decisions of the judges and Tournament Officials are final and are not subject to appeals.

20. Competitors may be disqualified for any violation of tournament rules or for unsportsmanlike conduct or abuse of Tournament Officials.

21. Fish can be measured all day between 8:00am and 3:00pm at the Tournament Headquarters.

22. Pike will be measured from the tip of the nose to the longest tip of the tail and will be scored 1 (one) point per inch.

23. Up to **5 pike in total** may be entered by any team throughout the day of the tournament. No more than 4 (four) Pike can be greater than 61cm (24 inches) and of which no more than 2 (two) can be greater than 86cm (33.9 inches) This is a live release tournament. In the opinion of the judges, the Pike can be kept alive. Each Pike that remains alive receives a 10 (ten) inch bonus.

24. In order to win the Big Fish Prize the fish must be kept alive.
